## DFI Guide to Join DFI Discord



### Method 1:


Register on Discord> Use the Invite link

1. Search Discord on the internet




Click the first link. It will redirect you to the signup/login page.

2. This is the Discord website. Here you can log in if you have an account created or Register/Sign up if you don't have a discord yet.




The sign-in option is on the top left for the web. It should be the same for mobile devices. There is an option called "Download" on the top right where you can get the desktop/Android/iOS app for Discord if you so wish. It also runs on a web browser.

Click on Login. It should open this Login screen. If you already have an account, put in your credentials and log in.



If you do not have an account yet, click "Register" located under the Log In button.

3. Clicking "Register" should open up this screen. Input your details and click continue.

## Method 2:

### Onboarding then Joining

The second method takes you to the DFI Discord server first, and then joining happens. In this method, find a DFI server invite. You can not join without an invite. Invites expire so ask around for a valid one. If you're in DFI, some members might have posted an invite that looks like this



1. Click on it. It will take you directly to the DFI Discord server. If you've logged out of your Discord account, you might have to re-login and then click on it.

2. Clicking on it will prompt Discord to ask you to pick a username. Input one and continue

Your screen should look something like this



3. Discord will ask you to "claim account" since you don't have a Discord account yet. It is the signup process. Click on the Claim Account button on the green banner on top.
4. In case you already have an account, just log in. If not, it will open this box

5. Input your email ID and click “Claim Account”. Verify via the email sent to your registered email account.
